- 2. WE HAVE SOME VERY SPECIFIC PERSONNEL NEEDS ON A COUPLE DIFFER-ENT TEAMS! PLEASE PRAY THAT THE LORD WILL SUPPLY OUR NEEDS AND FILL SOME KEY TEAM LEADER POSITIONS.
- 3. PLEASE CONTINUE TO PRAY FOR OUR MISSIONARIES' SAFETY IN DANGER-OUS AREAS IN AFRICA. PRAY FOR PEACE AND BOLDNESS IN THEIR MINIS-TRIES AND PERSONAL TESTIMONY.

The Body of Christ:

Adding Missionaries and Maturing the Believers

There is so much to unpack in Ephesians 4:11-16 about the body of Christ and all our different roles in it. In Him we each have different gifts and work together through the skills and talents that He Himself has given us. But what are we to use them for? Verse 12 says that we are to use these gifts to equip His people for works of service. It goes on to say that this is actually building up the body of Christ. So the Lord uses His body to build up His body. Like those workouts that only use your own muscles and your own body weight for resistance, we too are to build up all parts of the body. This is part of our purpose and our calling.

I think of the people I've met in Africa as I read on into verse 13. We are to be used by the Lord so that the rest of the body doesn't have to be infants anymore. There are so many people looking for any kind of hope they can find, and they are indeed "tossed back and forth by waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of people in their deceitful scheming." But how will they know unless the true body of Christ—people like you and me—are there to tell them?
